Dr. Begley joined Amgen in 2002. He graduated in medicine from the University of Melbourne in 1978, and then undertook further training at the Royal Melbourne Hospital, specializing in hematology and medical oncology.

During his PhD studies, Dr. Begley, in collaboration with Prof. Donald Metcalf, identified the human granulocyte colony-stimulating factor (G-CSF) and characterized the G-CSF receptor on

normal and leukemic human cells.

He has been actively involved in hematopoietic stem cell research, first cloning and characterizing the novel stem cell leukemia (SCL) gene, involved in human T-cell acute lymphoblastic leukemia.

Dr. Begley has also been involved in clinical studies of hematopoietic growth factors, demonstrating the utility of growth factor-mobilized peripheral blood stem cells, which has had significant impact in the field of bone marrow transplantation. He has won numerous awards and has published over 200 papers in scientific and medical journals.
