Dr Greg Roger, following his Medical Degree at Sydney University undertook a Masters degree in Engineering at Sydney University. Dr Roger went on to acquire a history of medical device innovation including co-designing and developing the highly successful Active Knee prosthesis.

The company he founded to produce Medical Devices, Advanced Surgical Design and Manufacture Limited (ASDM), has also helped the designs and inventions of other Australian surgeons and inventors to achieve commercialisation.

In 2004 Dr Roger received a Clunies Ross Award and in 2005 he received the Warren Centre Hero of Innovation Award and was appointed Adjunct Associate Professor in the School of Aerospace, Mechanical & Mechatronic Engineering at the University of Sydney. In 2006 Engineers Australia Sydney Division awarded Dr Roger Entrepreneur of the Year and in 2007 was named Alumnus of the Year by Sydney University's Faculty of Engineering and Information Technologies.
