Dr. Glick has been actively involved in agricultural research and development for over 35 years. He studied agronomy at McGill University in Montreal where he received a Bachelor of Science in Agriculture. He obtained his Masters degree in plant physiology at the University of Manitoba and received his Ph D at the University of Manitoba on full scholarship in plant physiology and biology. He has also completed an executive business management program at the University of Western Ontario.

After completing his formal education he joined the Canadian Wheat Board, an organization involved in international grain marketing. In 1985, after three years with the Wheat Board, he joined Monsanto as it was beginning to develop crop biotechnology programs.

Over the past 25 years at Monsanto, Harvey has lived and worked in Canada, Belgium and the US and currently is based in Singapore. He has held a variety of positions in the technology, commercial development and marketing organizations. He has been fortunate to visit and work in agricultural production systems in many different regions of the world with the objective of bringing new agricultural technology to producers. He helped introduce the first biotech crop to Canadian farmers in 1995 and has been actively involved in the development of biotech crops for Europe, Asia and the Americas. Currently he is Senior Director of Scientific Affairs for Asia and is directly involved in bringing the next generation of plant biotechnology products to farmers in China, India and Southeast Asia. He is a frequent speaker at conferences focused on agricultural biotechnology and sustainable food production systems. He is a board member on the Asia Food Information Council and the World Agricultural Forum Asia and is chairman of the Global Herbicide Resistance Committee. He is also active in CropLife Asia and the International Life Science Organization in South East Asia.
