Nick's particular interests include the pathophysiology and treatment of severe malaria and host and bacterial factors leading to severe *Staphylococcus aureus* disease, as well as the pathophysiology and treatment of dengue haemorrhagic fever, enteric fever, diphtheria and tetanus.

He has been in Bangkok for 7 years and has a special interest in understanding the major causes of disease burden in rural communities in South East Asia.
